

## Important Information for **International Travelers to the United States**

- Always carry a passport and printed Form I-20/DS-2019 with you.
- Make sure the F-1/J-1 visa in your passport is unexpired at the time of entry to the U.S.
- Your passport must be valid for at least 6 months into the future unless your country appears on the Passport Agreement List.
- Be respectful and responsive to security enforcement professionals.
- If you need emergency help at an airport or other U.S. Port of Entry, call Rutgers Global–International Student and Scholar Services during office hours (M–T, Th–F, 8:30 a.m.–5:00 p.m.). See other side for phone numbers.
- Update all address, email, and phone number changes within 10 days.
