FOR ALL CONTINUING STUDENTS: Between August 28 and August 30, the international student services staff will be extremely busy helping 1,300+ new international students navigate the Rutgers system. Please consider holding any questions you may have for our advisors until AFTER orientation. As you may remember from your own orientation to Rutgers, our new students will have many questions, and our staff will be busy helping them get acclimated. We will resume our regular office hours and Quick Question Advising (QQA) for all international

students on Thursday, August 31. Remote and in-person advising appointments will resume on Tuesday, September 5. Thank you in advance for your patience and understanding.

As always, our staff will do their best to reply to emails within 48 hours, however, please be patient while waiting for a response. Someone from our office will respond to you as soon as possible. Please also note that all university units will be closed on Monday, September 4, 2023 in observance of Labor Day.

ENROLLMENT REQUIREMENTS FOR ALL INTERNATIONAL STUDENTS

Due to the SEVP termination of COVID-19 flexibilities, please remember that F-1 and J-1 students will not be permitted to count more than one online class or 3 credits toward a full course of study requirement for the 2023-2024 academic year.

This means that undergraduate students may count no more than 3 credits of online coursework toward the 12-credit full-time coursework requirement, and graduate students may count no more than 3 credits of online coursework toward the 9-credit full-time coursework requirement. Hybrid courses count as in-person classes.

REMINDER TO UPLOAD COVID-19 VACCINATION INFORMATION

For the university policy, guidelines, and further information on quarantine, testing, and vaccination, please review the Rutgers University-wide COVID-19 Information website (<u>https://coronavirus.rutgers.edu/</u>).

Please note that students attending International Student Orientation (ISO) must comply with the university's <u>COVID-19 Immunization Record Requirement for Students, Policy 10.3.14</u>.

Please make sure you upload your proof of vaccination through the <u>Rutgers Immunization</u> <u>Portal.</u> Students who fail to comply with this requirement will be removed from their courses. APPLYING FOR A SOCIAL SECURITY NUMBER

F-1 and J-1 students must have a job offer letter and/or work authorization to be eligible to apply for a Social Security Number (SSN). Eligible students must follow the detailed instructions on our <u>Social Security</u> webpage, under How to Apply for a Social Security number.

Please note the latest updates from the Social Security Administration include:

• Appointments are optional and may be scheduled by calling 877-803-6313 or 888-221-9983. Otherwise, the mandatory in-person interviews are granted on a walk-in basis.

- Applicants may now utilize the <u>online SSN application</u> before attending the mandatory inperson interview.
- SSN applicants who traveled internationally and have arrived to the US by air must wait 10 days before visiting the NB SSA office. This rule does not apply to applicants who entered the US by car or bus.

REDUCED CREDIT/COURSE LOAD – FALL 2023 DEADLINE IS WEDNESDAY, SEPTEMBER 27

To maintain legal status, all F-1 and J-1 students must pursue a full course of study at all times. This means being registered for a full credit load (12 credits for undergraduates and 9 credits for graduate students). There are cases, however, in which regulations consider a student to be pursuing a full course of study even though he or she is NOT actually registered for a full credit load. This may apply to undergraduates who only need 1 or 2 classes to complete their program, or graduate students who have completed all coursework, but are still conducting thesis or dissertation research. This may be considered as pursuing a full course of study even though not being registered for 9 or 12 credits.

Please refer to the <u>Reduced Credit/Course Load</u> webpage to review the specific circumstances that render a student eligible for a Reduced Course/Credit Load. For students who are pursuing off-campus employment with authorized CPT, we remind you that full-time CPT is not an acceptable reason for a Reduced Credit/Course Load.

IF YOU WILL BE REGISTERED FOR LESS THAN A FULL-TIME CREDIT LOAD IN FALL 2023, you MUST submit a "Reduced Credit/Course Load" form to ISSS using the <u>RGlobal portal</u>. You will need approval from our office for less than full-time enrollment in any semester. The form can be completed online and will require your graduate program director/academic dean's approval. Please review our <u>website</u> for instructions and information about the updated process to submit this form. The deadline for submitting the form is **Wednesday, September 27, 2023.**

Please check the University's academic calendar for the appropriate add/drop dates, for the last date to drop classes without a "W" grade:

Bear in mind that it takes 3-4 days to process the form after receipt and we cannot guarantee timely processing of forms received after the deadline. This could mean loss of legal status and you will need to leave the country or apply for a reinstatement process with the US government.

Remember, the "Reduced Credit/Course Load" form can be submitted at any time before the deadline, but no later than September 27, 2023.

STUDENTS WITH A TA/GA APPOINTMENT

Students with full TA/GA appointments who are enrolled in benefits through University Human Resources DO NOT need to contact our office to request a waiver of the student health insurance premium. You only need to submit your enrollment paperwork through Human Resources at the start of your appointment and do not need to submit waiver documentation to our office. Once Human Resources processes your insurance enrollment paperwork we will receive your coverage information and we will process your waiver.

ALL OTHER F-1 AND J-1 STUDENTS MUST <u>EITHER</u> ENROLL OR WAIVE:

STEPS TO COMPLETE HEALTH INSURANCE ENROLLMENT – DEADLINE IS FRIDAY, SEPTEMBER 22

- Register for classes. Wait three business days after registering for classes to complete the enrollment form at <u>universityhealthplans.com</u>.
- Change your International address to a U.S. mailing address, visit <u>my.rutgers.edu/portal</u>. You may do this once you are registered for classes.
- Add your email address, visit <u>my.rutgers.edu/portal</u>. You may do this once you are registered.
- Three days after registering for classes, go to <u>universityhealthplans.com</u> to complete the enrollment form. You will receive a confirmation number on the screen and to your Rutgers email, once you have successfully submitted the enrollment form.
- Wait four days after receiving your enrollment confirmation number, go to <u>University</u> <u>Health Plans, Inc</u>. On the left navigation bar, select "Log into my account." You may then create an account, log in, and print your card.

OR

STEPS TO WAIVE THE STUDENT HEALTH INSURANCE FOR STUDENTS IN F-1 or J-1 VISA STATUS -DEADLINE IS FRIDAY, SEPTEMBER 22

F-1 and J-1 students on a Rutgers sponsorship who have insurance coverage other than the student insurance plan that is charged on their term bills need to request a waiver of that insurance premium by following the exemption request process outlined below. Please note that Rutgers-sponsored international students cannot waive the student insurance plan through the United Healthcare website; it must be done through Rutgers Global – International Student and Scholar Services. The deadline for submitting the waiver is Friday, September 22, 2023.

Please complete the following steps to request the waiver:

- Review supporting documents you will need to provide or address to complete the exemption, all supporting documents must confirm that your coverage meets every one of <u>the University's health insurance requirements</u>.
- Apply for the insurance waiver by completing the form available through our <u>RGlobal</u> <u>Student Services Portal</u> on the ISSS website.
- Submit the form and any supporting documents to the ISSS by Friday, September 22, 2023, to opt out of the university's student insurance plan and have the premium removed from the term bill.

****Important Note: Students on another institution's visa sponsorship** who are registered for a full-time course load and hold coverage other than the student insurance plan will need to waive their student insurance premium by following the <u>online waiver instructions</u>.
