### Academic Planning Tips

To determine how study abroad can benefit your degree completion, please use these questions to get started in your planning meetings.



#### Questions to ask an academic advisor in your school:

- What are the graduation requirements for my degree?
- What are the remaining requirements I must fulfill in order to graduate?
- What core/major/minor requirements can I take during my semester abroad and how will study abroad contribute to my progress?



#### Questions to ask a department advisor if you have a major or minor (declared or intended):

- How many lower-level and/or upper-level credits do I need to complete for my desired major and/or minor?
- What remaining prerequisites must be fulfilled before I study abroad?
- What credits earned on my study abroad program can be used to fulfill my major/minor requirements?



#### Questions to ask a study abroad advisor:

- Based on my general interests of study abroad and my desired major/minor, what study abroad programs might fit my needs?
- How can I get courses approved for my program(s) of interest?
- What do I need to consider in preparing for my travel?
- How can I contact Rutgers students who have participated in my program(s) of interest?
