

# Withdrawal Policy

After you have been accepted to the ROSE program and paid the required deposit(s), you are considered an enrolled participant in that program. By making such payment you are expressing your intention to participate in the ROSE program, you are acknowledging that the program fee deposit will be transferred into your regular tuition bill if enrolling into the ROSE program or withdrawing ROSE to attend Rutgers in-person in New Jersey or Rutgers fully online semester before September 1<sup>st</sup>, 2021; however, if you withdraw from the ROSE program after July 15<sup>th</sup> 2021 and do not attend ROSE, Rutgers in-person courses in New Jersey, or Rutgers fully online courses, the program fee will NOT be refundable or transferable; the housing deposit is non-transferable and non-refundable after the dates listed below, and you are recognizing that you will be held responsible for some or all of the full program fee, even if ultimately you do not participate in the program, depending on when you formally withdraw from the program. “Refunds” after July 15<sup>th</sup> will be applied in the form of transferring to your term bill.

If you are considering withdrawing from the ROSE program for which you have already paid a program deposit, then review this policy and take the following steps:

1. Speak with a Rutgers Global ROSE advisor as well as your school advisor. We may be able to help you find a way to still participate, even if withdrawing seems inevitable.
2. Review the timelines below: Remember: program fee deposits are transferred to their term bills up to September 1<sup>st</sup> if enrolling in a ROSE program, Rutgers semester in New Jersey, or Rutgers fully online semester. Students withdrawing from ROSE and Rutgers will not have their deposits refunded after July 15<sup>th</sup> unless the ROSE program is cancelled by Rutgers. After September 1<sup>st</sup> 2021, your participation in ROSE will be regarded as confirmed and program deposit will be non-refundable.
  - a. Housing deposits are non-refundable after July 15<sup>th</sup>, 2021 and are non-transferable. If you withdraw from housing after July 15<sup>th</sup> through August 28<sup>th</sup>, and still attend Rutgers, the remaining amount after the cancellation fee will be transferred to your term bill. If the amount owed is greater than the deposit, the balance still owed will appear on your term bill for you to pay.
3. If, after speaking with ROSE advisors and your school advisor you still intend to withdraw, then you must complete, sign, and submit the Withdrawal Form.

**Withdrawals are not considered official and valid until a completed WITHDRAWAL FORM is emailed to the ROSE staff. Withdrawals will be effective on the date we receive your email with the completed and signed Withdrawal Form attached.**

<b>Program Fee Deposit:</b>	
If you withdraw <b>BEFORE:</b>	Then your <b>deposits</b> are:
July 15 <sup>th</sup> , 2021	Refundable if you withdraw from both ROSE and Rutgers.
September 1 <sup>st</sup> , 2021	Rolled into general tuition bill IF you attend Rutgers either in-person in New Jersey or fully online for the Fall 2021 semester.
If you withdraw <b>ON</b> or <b>AFTER:</b>	Then your <b>deposits</b> are:

July 15 <sup>th</sup> , 2021	Non-refundable for students who are withdrawing from Rutgers.
September 1 <sup>st</sup> , 2021	Non-refundable for all students

If you withdraw <b>ON</b> or <b>AFTER</b> :	Then your <b>deposits</b> are:
June 23 <sup>th</sup> , 2021	Refundable or transferable
July 15 <sup>th</sup> , 2021	Non-refundable / non-transferable based on below cancellation fees
<b>Housing Payment Cancellation Fee:</b>	
If you withdraw <b>Between</b> :	Then your <b>Housing Cancellation Fees</b> are:
June – July 15 <sup>th</sup> , 2021	Refundable or transferable
July 15 <sup>th</sup> , 2021 - July 31 <sup>st</sup> , 2021	25% Cancellation Fee
August 1 <sup>st</sup> – August 14 <sup>th</sup> , 2021	50% Cancellation Fee
August 15 <sup>th</sup> – August 27 <sup>h</sup> , 2021	75% Cancellation Fee
August 28 <sup>th</sup> , 2021	100% Non-refundable and non-transferable
